## Milk and Medicine Sponsors . . . An answer to a mother's prayer

Infant formula and food supplements enable families in crisis to feed their babies.  
\$20 monthly feeds one child.

A household trying to survive on \$1 a day can't afford a single can of infant formula or even a small bottle of milk. An infant cannot survive without milk. When an infant's life is in danger, Milk and Medicine is an answer to a mother's prayer.



**A young girl whose mother died in childbirth says:** "We have been helped a lot because otherwise my sister was going to die, for we did not know what to do about her. She was too little to survive without milk, which I didn't have."

**A widowed grandmother caring for her orphaned grandson explained:** "Before he started the milk program he was sick and very thin. At one time I thought he was going to die and I lost hope and was full of fear. Now he is big and even looking so nice and fat."

**A widowed mother described her fear and hopelessness:** "I started coming here after my husband died, and I had no food, I had no money to buy milk for my daughter. Now I have seen my daughter come back to life. You know what it is

like when you see your baby dying, and I thought she would soon follow her father in death. But thank God my daughter is alive."

Sponsors are a critical part of the Alliance for Children Everywhere team. Safety Net sponsors serve by "adopting" a child during the critical time they are in one of our homes. We rely heavily on Safety Net Sponsors to surround each individual boy and girl with prayer and to help provide for their daily needs.

By email, sponsors receive a picture, profile and special prayer needs of an individual child. Monthly updates, usually with a picture, keep sponsors informed and able to pray intelligently.

When a child moves into a family, the sponsor is given another child who needs extra care through a crisis time.



A large part of our ministry is to find a suitable, stable family, for the children either from the extended family or through adoption. We never know how long an individual child will be with us because no matter how excellent our care is, children grow best in families.

**Safety Net sponsor, Maureen writes:** "In Zambia, orphaned children strap younger siblings to their back and beg in the streets. I can't be there, but I can help from where I am now.

That's why I'm a Safety Net Sponsor. Our whole family reads the updates and our refrigerator is full of pictures. Our children pray for our sponsored baby every day and are always excited to see the new pictures and updates each month. Thank you for including us in these precious lives."



Maureen and her family are now sponsoring their 8th child. Throughout their four years of being Safety Net Sponsors they have been personally involved in the process of their sponsored children becoming reunited with healed families, or joining with new families through adoptions.
